



DECORATIVE FILM

In comparison to printing directly on glass, a residue-free removal of the printed film is possible (with little effort, without glass damage). A digital print on film is also less costly. Disassembling of the window is not necessary – when printing on the glass this would be a must!

The printing process allows a full color print in the CMYK color mode. Therefore, there is almost no limit to the choice of Design: photographic picture motives, logos, text, patterns, ornaments and many more.

The film creates additional benefits depending on the type of film used: safety, heat reduction, UV protection, privacy.

### Film-to-Glass Guide

When outside glazing is partially or completely filmed, thermal stress can cause glass damage. This does not affect glazing inside the building without direct sunlight or notable temperature fluctuations.
